### **Reviewer's report:**

The authors have made many changes to improve this paper. I am still concerned that the conclusion makes statements that are not warranted by this study design, i.e. the results suggest a difference in satisfaction between the two non-randomly selected samples, but do not provide evidence that NT should be used more frequently or included in medical education.

**Level of interest:** An article of limited interest

**Quality of written English:** Needs some language corrections before being published

**Statistical review:** No, the manuscript does not need to be seen by a statistician.
