1.Tables 1-5 treatment of control animals with 0.9% saline(normal saline)-dose of norml saline has been mentioned as 5mg/kg insted of 5ml/kg

2.insted of using the word"moist weight" of cotton pellet, change to "wet weight" in the results and discussion section

3.The rationale of using various acute inflammatory models with out elucidating the antiinflammatory action of the extract is not justified. The investigators could have used a better standndard NSAID for comaprison
